DUTIES: The successful candidate will be responsible for providing academic instruction to students enrolled in College of the North Atlantic's Practical Nursing Program at Happy Valley-Goose Bay Campus. The candidate will facilitate learning in theory/classroom, lab, and clinical settings; plan, deliver, and evaluate student progress; organize and manage instructional materials and learning resources; provide academic advising to students; evaluate student progress; and other duties consistent with maintaining quality student-centered instruction may also be required. This position will be required for 30 hours per week and with an increase in hours during clinical rotations throughout each semester.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must possess extensive knowledge in nursing and safe work practices in a clinical environment. Knowledge of classroom management and teaching methods currently being utilized in post-secondary education is essential. Exceptional oral and written communication skills, problem solving skills, and organizational skills, in addition to the ability to collaborate and work effectively as a member of a faculty team is also required. Demonstrating a strong commitment to student success and the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with students, faculty, and external contacts of the College will be critical to the success of this role. The required qualifications would have been acquired through the successful completion of a Bachelor of Nursing Degree with at least three (3) years of recent and relevant work experience in the nursing profession. The successful candidate must be registered with ARNNL prior to commencing employment.
