**DUTIES:** You will instruct students, facilitate learning and evaluate student progress for students enrolled in the Powerline Technician Program. You will plan, organize and manage learning activities and resources in classroom and shop settings and will provide academic advising services. You will teach all of the courses outlined in the Powerline Technician Plan of Training, including both theory and practical. Instructional topics may include pole and climbing safety, AC and DC theory, rigging, structures, mobile training, line work, line design and drawing, above and underground systems and specific terminology associated with the trade. You will also be required to prepare learner performance reports and prior learning assessments as required by the Department of Advanced Education, Skills, and Labour as well as other related duties consistent with maintaining quality student-centered instruction.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** The successful candidates must demonstrate knowledge of power line work and its practical application in industry. Candidates must have knowledge of classroom management and teaching practices. Strong oral and written communication, analytical, conflict resolution and organizational skills are required in this role. The ability to work independently but also collaboratively as a member of an instructional team while demonstrating a strong commitment to student success will be essential. The ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships in a classroom and shop setting with faculty, staff and students is also required. The required knowledge and skills would have been obtained through Interprovincial Journeyman Certification in Powerline Technician with a minimum of six (6) years combined apprenticeship training and recent and relevant trade specific industry experience. A Pre-employment Certificate, Bachelor of Education (Secondary/Post-Secondary), teacher training, experience teaching at a post-secondary level and basic computer literacy skills would all be considered assets.
