DUTIES: The role of the Clinical Instructor will be to deliver clinical instruction to students enrolled in the Practical Nursing Program at College of the North Atlantic's Happy Valley-Goose Bay Campus. Teaching in a clinical environment provides students with an opportunity to become proficient in previously learned hands-on skills associated with the practical nursing profession through guidance, assessment, and feedback. The Clinical Instructor will incorporate their own teaching style to existing lesson plans while meeting the learning objectives of the course material; work closely with other faculty members to ensure a coordinated and consistent teaching approach; engage students to enhance their learning; and meet with students regularly to gauge progress and proficiency in various hands-on skills. Other related duties consistent with providing and maintaining quality student-centered instruction will be required. This position may also require course delivery and evaluation in a classroom and/or laboratory environment.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must possess extensive knowledge in nursing. Knowledge of classroom management including teaching and learning methods currently being utilized in post-secondary education is essential. Exceptional oral and written communication skills, problem solving skills, and organizational skills, in addition to the ability to collaborate and work effectively as a member of a faculty team is also required. Demonstrating a strong commitment to student success and the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with students, faculty, and external contacts of the College will be critical to the success of this role. These qualifications would have been acquired through the successful completion of a Bachelor of Nursing Degree with at least three (3) years of recent and relevant work experience in the nursing profession. The successful candidate must have an active practicing license with ARNNL prior to commencing employment.
