College of the North Atlantic has embarked upon an exciting pilot project designed to deliver the Early Childhood Education (ECE) Certificate program to participants in Northern Labrador. The college is currently seeking a dynamic, qualified Early Childhood Educator who is committed to teaching the current ECE curriculum while utilizing indigenized resources and materials. Working under the supervision of the College of the North Atlantic (CNA) Campus Director – Happy Valley-Goose Bay (HVGB) Campus, the successful candidate is also supported by a project team committee.

DUTIES: The successful candidate will be responsible for instructing students in Nain, Labrador, who are enrolled in the CNA Early Childhood Education Certificate Program, with indigenized aspects included. The curriculum delivery will occur at the Pigutsavik Centre and student field placements will be taking place in-community. In addition to planning and delivering course objectives, the incumbent will be responsible for evaluating student progress; organizing and managing instructional materials and the learning environment; providing academic advice to learners; supervising and mentoring students on field placements; and performing other related duties associated with the project and consistent with maintaining quality learner-centered instruction.

QUALIFICATIONS: The successful candidate must have well-developed communication, facilitation, analytical, conflict resolution, organizational and classroom management skills combined with the ability to work independently while establishing and maintaining effective working relationships is required. The incumbent must demonstrate a student-centered approach to teaching and a commitment to student success strategies and initiatives. Knowledge and experience with computer applications is required. The successful candidate must possess the following: Level IV Child Care Services Certification which includes Bachelor Degree in Early Childhood Education, or Bachelor Degree and Early Childhood Education Diploma (min. 2 yr.) and minimally 3 yrs. experience (2 years as part of adult-child ratio in licensed child care centre).

A B.Ed. (Secondary/Post-Secondary); eligibility for membership in an appropriate professional association; teaching experience at post-secondary level; skilled in the delivery of indigenous curriculum; familiarly with the local area; familiarity with online course delivery and fluency in the native language are considered assets.

SALARY: Commensurate with qualifications and experience in accordance with the College of the North Atlantic Faculty Collective Agreement.
