DUTIES: The role of the Clinical Instructor will be to deliver clinical instruction to students enrolled in the Practical Nursing Program at College of the North Atlantic's Happy Valley – Goose Bay Campus. Teaching in a clinical environment provides students with an opportunity to become proficient in previously learned hands-on skills associated with the practical nursing profession through guidance, assessment, and feedback. The Clinical Instructor will incorporate their own teaching style to existing lesson plans while meeting the learning objectives of the course material; work with other faculty members to ensure a coordinated and consistent teaching approach to ensure the planned curriculum for each course is delivered; prepare and implement various instructional strategies, techniques, and learning modules using an approved curriculum to achieve specified learning outcomes; establish student performance objectives and evaluation methods; meet with students regularly to gauge and evaluate progress; communicate effectively at a level appropriate to the ability of students and provide an emotionally safe learning environment that is conducive to learning; maintain appropriate clinical discipline following college and the respective health authority's policies and procedures; and identify and resolve problem areas in learning. Other related duties consistent with providing and maintaining quality student-centered instruction will be required. This position may also require course delivery and evaluation in a classroom and/or laboratory environment.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must possess extensive knowledge in nursing and have an understanding of clinical instruction practices including teaching and learning methods currently being utilized in a similar environment. Exceptional oral and written communication, problem solving, and organizational skills in addition to the ability to collaborate and work effectively as a member of a faculty team is also required. Demonstrating a strong commitment to student success and the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with faculty, students, and the health authority will be essential for this role. The required qualifications would have been obtained through the successful completion of a Bachelor of Nursing Degree with at least three (3) years of recent and relevant work experience in the nursing profession. The successful candidate must have an active practicing license with ARNNL prior to commencing employment. Retired nurses in possession of an undergraduate degree in nursing are welcome to apply!

SALARY: Commensurate with qualifications and experience in accordance with the College of the North Atlantic Faculty Collective Agreement.
