**DUTIES:** The role of the Instructor will be to facilitate learning to students in theory and in a clinical setting as part of the Personal Care Attendant program at College of the North Atlantic's Prince Philip Drive Campus. The Instructor will be the subject matter expert in continuing care and incorporate their own teaching style to existing lesson plans while meeting the learning objectives of the course material; work with other faculty members to ensure a coordinated and consistent teaching approach; engage students to enhance their learning; create an environment that's conducive to learning; plan and manage learning activities; provide academic advising to students; and meet with students regularly to gauge and evaluate progress and proficiency in various hands-on skills. Other related duties consistent with providing and maintaining quality student-centered instruction will be required. This position will be required for 20 hours per week with the exception of a 4 week placement when hours will increase to 30-35 per week. There may be some flexibility with scheduling in order to accommodate other work commitments if the successful candidate is employed part-time or full-time elsewhere.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidates must possess knowledge in continuing care. Knowledge of teaching and learning methods currently being utilized in a similar teaching and learning environment is essential. Exceptional communication, problem solving, and organizational skills, in addition to the ability to collaborate and work effectively as a member of a faculty team is also required. Demonstrating a strong commitment to student success and the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with staff, faculty, and students will be required of the successful incumbent. Registered Nurses or Licensed Practical Nurses with 5 years of recent and relevant work experience, preferably with 2 years in continuing care, will be considered. Current practicing license with ARNNL or CLPNNL is required.

**SALARY:** Commensurate with qualifications and experience in accordance with the College of the North Atlantic Faculty Collective Agreement.
