The CAS is tasked with providing support for all aspects of curriculum development, implementation, assessment, and revision. The Curriculum Assessment Specialist guides faculty through resource development, selection of level-appropriate texts and materials, assessment development, and assessment administration. The CAS organizes and facilitates orientation and professional development related to curriculum and assessment, conducts needs assessments, reviews literature, and facilitates focus groups and consultative meetings with a variety of stakeholders to elicit curriculum and assessment feedback and suggest and implement modifications. The CAS schedules and oversees exam development and implementation to ensure they meet rigorous quality standards, and, where relevant, accrediting and certifying agencies. The CAS composes a variety of academic documentation and provides support in the development and implementation of policies, procedures, and guidelines governing the PDAQ and maintains familiarity with CNA-Q curriculum and assessment requirements.

Your qualifications

A Master's in Education, with a focus in curriculum and instruction, and/or adult and workplace education, and five years of relevant work experience is required. Experience in post-secondary education with an in-depth knowledge of the principles of curriculum development and assessment, accreditation, project management, adult teaching and learning strategies, and continuous improvement processes is essential. Demonstrated excellence in academic and technical writing, including the effective use of technology to manage and maintain documentation and version control under established quality guidelines and standards is required. Expertise in needs analysis, facilitation, and evaluation methods would be a definite asset. This position requires excellent organizational, time-management, problem-solving, decision-making, analytical, and data analysis skills. Excellent interpersonal, communication, and presentation skills with expert fluency in English are essential. Intercultural competence including intercultural sensitivity and adaptability, and the ability to conduct oneself appropriately and effectively in another culture, are essential. Knowledge of the CNA college system and its programs will be considered an asset.
