**DUTIES:** The role of the Instructor will be to facilitate learning to students in theory and lab as part of the Medical Laboratory Sciences Program at College of the North Atlantic's Prince Philip Drive Campus. The Instructor will incorporate their own teaching style to existing lesson plans while meeting the learning objectives of the course material; work with other faculty members to ensure a coordinated and consistent teaching approach to ensure the planned curriculum for each course is delivered; prepare and implement various instructional strategies, techniques, and learning modules using an approved curriculum to achieve specified learning outcomes; establish student performance objectives and evaluation methods; meet with students regularly to gauge and evaluate progress; communicate effectively at a level appropriate to the ability of students and provide an emotionally safe learning environment that is conducive to learning; maintain appropriate classroom discipline following college policies and procedures; identify and resolve problem areas in learning; provide academic advising to students; participate in professional development activities to remain current in the MLS and post-secondary education profession; and actively participate in and contribute to accreditation activities to ensure the program is of the highest standard. Other related duties consistent with providing and maintaining quality student-centered instruction will be required.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidates must be current in their profession and possess extensive knowledge in medical laboratory sciences. An understanding of classroom management including teaching methods currently being utilized in post-secondary education is essential. Exceptional oral and written communication skills, problem solving skills, and organizational skills, in addition to the ability to collaborate and work effectively as a member of a faculty team, and demonstrating a strong commitment to student success and the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with students and staff will be required. Candidates must be a Medical Laboratory Technologist (M.L.T.) and hold a relevant degree with at least five years of recent and relevant work experience. Current provincial registration with Newfoundland and Labrador College of Health Professionals (NLCHP) and membership in the Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Science (CSMLS) is required prior to commencing employment.
