**DUTIES:** As part of the team providing instruction at the Burin Campus, the successful candidate will be responsible for instructing Mathematics to students enrolled in the Comprehensive Arts and Sciences (CAS) College - University Transfer Program. The incumbent will plan, deliver, and evaluate student progress; organize and manage instructional materials and the learning environment; maintain supplies and equipment; be responsible for providing academic advice for learners about their programs and courses, as well as evaluation of student progress; and perform other duties consistent with maintaining quality learner-centered instruction.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** The successful candidate must possess the extensive knowledge of Mathematics required to teach Introductory University-Level Math courses, as well as current teaching and learning methods. Well-developed communication, facilitation, analytical, conflict resolution, organizational and classroom management skills combined with the ability to work independently while establishing and maintaining effective working relationships are required. The incumbent must demonstrate a student-centered approach to teaching and a commitment to student success strategies and initiatives. The required knowledge and skills would have been acquired through the completion of Master of Arts or Science with a concentration in Mathematics, with recent, related work experience, preferably in a Post-Secondary teaching environment. A supplemental Bachelor of Education Degree (Secondary or Post-Secondary) would be considered an asset. Candidates demonstrating a Bachelor of Arts or Science Degree with a major in Mathematics, supplemented by a Bachelor of Education (Secondary/Post-Secondary) and a related M.Ed. may be considered.
