DUTIES: The Cook I is an important member of the Food Service team at College of the North Atlantic's Happy Valley – Goose Bay Campus. The position's primary responsibilities include the preparation, cooking and serving of meals for the cafeteria and for other special functions. The Cook I will use a variety of cooking equipment, prepare and store food in a safe and sanitary manner, clean and sanitize workstation and equipment, meet with their supervisor to plan cafeteria specials and maintain inventory. This position may require lifting and moving large objects including bulk food and kitchen equipment; standing for long periods throughout a typical shift; and the use of a variety of kitchen equipment requiring controlled movements. Other duties related to the efficient operation of a commercial kitchen may be necessary and candidates are expected to be available on short notice when required. This position is included in the bargaining unit (NAPE, Support Staff).

QUALIFICATIONS: In order to be successful in this role, candidates are required to demonstrate a thorough knowledge of the culinary arts industry including food preparation, service, safety and sanitation in a commercial kitchen. Excellent communication, problem solving and organizational skills are important for this role. Candidates are also expected to demonstrate high standards and take great pride in their work. The ability to interact and establish professional working relationships with students, staff and faculty is essential. Candidates must also show a willingness to collaborate and work well as a member of a food service team. These qualifications would have been acquired through the successful completion of a one (1) year Certificate in Commercial Cooking (or related) supplemented by recent and relevant industry experience in food preparation and service.
