DUTIES: The successful candidate will be responsible for providing assistance to Instructors in the planning, preparation, and delivery of instructional materials to students within College of the North Atlantic's Medical Laboratory Sciences Program at Prince Philip Drive Campus. The incumbent will work closely with students to model appropriate behaviours and will be accountable for the demonstration of specific skills, tasks, experiments, and/or work practices in a classroom, laboratory, or clinical setting. The successful candidate will also perform other related duties consistent with maintaining quality learner-centered instruction. This position may require evening work.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must possess extensive knowledge of medical lab sciences. Knowledge of classroom management including teaching methods currently being utilized in post-secondary education is essential. Exceptional communication skills, problem solving skills, and organizational skills, in addition to the ability to collaborate and work effectively as a member of a faculty team is also required. Demonstrating a strong commitment to student success and the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with students, faculty, and external contacts of the College will be critical to the success of this role. Candidates must be a Medical Lab Technologist (M.L.T.) with at least four (4) years of recent and relevant work experience. Current membership in the Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Science (CSMLS) is required prior to commencing employment.
