**DUTIES:** This position is responsible for maintaining and repairing work in the mechanical, electrical, plumbing, carpentry and electronic trades at or near the journey person level. Employees in this class may possess a journey person certificate in a trade but are deemed to be functioning below the full working level of a Trades Worker II. Employees with this class work with some independence and may act as lead hand to subordinate positions. Work is assigned based on experience, complexity of duties and familiarity of the employee with building systems.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** The successful applicant must have experience in a mechanical, electrical, plumbing, electronic or carpentry trade. The incumbent may be required occasionally to lift or move objects up to 50 lbs. The incumbent must possess good analytical, organizational and communication skills and the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships. These qualifications would normally be acquired and demonstrated through graduation from Level III of High School supplemented by courses in a trade from a Postsecondary Institution or completion of a carpentry journey person certificate or any equivalent combination of experience and training. Incumbent must also possess a Valid Driver's Licence.
