DUTIES: The primary assignment of the successful candidate will be to assist the instructors of the Agriculture Technician Program with planning, organizing and managing learning activities for the program by assisting with instructional design, course development, and student evaluation. The incumbent will work closely with students to model appropriate behaviours and is generally accountable for the demonstration of specific skills, tasks, or work practices in a field/laboratory setting. The Instructional Assistant will assist the Instructor with any courses that have a field/laboratory component including, but not limited to: farm facilities, soil fundamentals, agriculture safety, vegetable and fruit production, tillage and planting, farm equipment operation, and livestock farming. The instructional assistant will work with program instructors to identify the equipment needs for specific field/laboratory activities and will be responsible for equipment servicing and maintenance. The successful candidate will also perform other related duties consistent with maintaining quality student-centered.
