The Engineering Division, Deer Lake, of the Department of Transportation and Works provides engineering design services, contract implementation and supervision and associated functions related to the design, construction, rehabilitation or maintenance of highways and associated structures, wharves, airstrips and provincial government buildings.

Your responsibilities include, but not limited to:

- Assisting regional staff with the contract administration on Capital Projects involving construction, upgrading and rehabilitation of highways and associated structures.
- Depending on the nature of the project, duties may include surveying, sieve analysis, concrete testing, drafting and quantity calculations.

The student's headquarters will be at the Deer Lake Regional Office. However, travel throughout the region may be required.

You will be expected to perform work as part of a team as well as work independently when required. You must also possess effective organizational, analytical and communication skills and must be detail oriented. Please submit a copy of your transcript with your application.
